

## CHANG LING LEE MEMORIAL LECTURESHIP

- 1) To be given annually at an ILABB-sponsored meeting.
- 2) Given to the person (Blood Bank Physician, Supervisor, Technologist, Researcher, Administrator, Donor Recruiter, Nurse or Educator) who by majority vote of the ILABB Board of Directors is one of the most outstanding contributors to Transfusion Medicine in Illinois.
- 3) Nominations may be made by any member of the ILABB. The board will discuss each nomination and vote for the recipient of the award from nominations received. ILABB board members currently serving are not eligible for nomination.

Criteria for selection include:

- a. Significant contributions to the field of Transfusion Medicine as measured by research, teaching, clinical practice, and management accomplishments.
  - b. Publications, presentations
  - c. Service to local, state, national and international blood banking organizations.
- 4) Candidate must practice blood banking in Illinois.
  - 5) Candidate must provide a keynote lecture (approximately one-hour) on a blood bank-related topic. The presentation can be at the meeting where the award is to be presented or at another meeting following the award presentation.
  - 6) The award is to consist of an honorarium and plaque.
